Lillian May Eischeid, age 97, of Carroll, passed away, Sunday, March 10, 2019 at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

They made their home in Carroll, Iowa, where Lillian was a housewife and mother, but also held jobs Burke Hotel, and her favorite position as receptionist at son-in-law, Tom Sporrer's, cabinet shop, the Carroll Cabinet Company. Lillian made sure everyone had a birthday cake, and always had a cookie jar full of homemade cookies for every visitor. She loved to travel at an early age with her Grandpa Petersen, and later traveled with family across the United States. She was a three-time cancer survivor and true fighter.
