Born on September 15, 1927 at Roselle, Iowa, Luella Margaret was the daughter of Bernard and Mary (Meier) Bluml. She spent her younger years in the Roselle area and attended Holy Angels School.

On March 5, 1946 she was united in marriage to LaVerdos Reis at Holy Family Catholic Church in Lidderdale. The couple farmed in the Breda and Auburn area until 1986 when they moved to their home in Auburn. Throughout her working career Luella was employed at Waters Clothing Store in Carroll, Snappy Popcorn in Breda, and also cooked at Stewart Memorial Hospital in Lake City.

Luella was a talented homemaker and enjoyed sewing, cooking, hosting family gatherings, and always opened her home to welcome family and her many friends.
