Madeline "Midge" Hoffman, 93 of Carroll, died early Monday morning, May 5, 2014 at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Mass of Christian Burial will be at 2:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 8, 2014 at Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Johnson. Con-Celebrant will be Fr. Paul Louis Arts. Born on September 13, 1920 at Templeton, Iowa, Madeline Lauretta was the daughter of John and Katherine (Greteman) Schwaller. She spent her younger years in the Templeton area attending Sacred Heart School and later

graduated from Manning High School.

On September 22, 1942 she was united in marriage to Frank Hoffman at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Templeton, with Msgr. F.H. Huesman officiating. Midge and Frank made their home northeast of Dedham and she worked outside the home at various jobs in the Carroll area. In 1985 the couple moved to Carroll. Midge was gifted at crocheting and received awards at the Iowa State Fair and also crocheted many items for family and friends. She enjoyed being around people, was a former member of St. Joseph's Parish in Dedham, former member of Dedham American Legion Auxiliary, and was a member of Holy Spirit Parish in Carroll.
