Madonna Boeckman, 83 of Breda, died late Thursday evening, March 10, 2016 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll surrounded by her family.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 1:30 p.m. Monday, March 14, 2016 at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. The Celebrant will be Fr. Gary Snyder. Born on October 10, 1932 in Carroll, Iowa, Madonna was the daughter of Walter and Christine (Grote) Snyder. She spent her entire lifetime in the Breda community and was a graduate of St. Bernard's High School in 1950.

On June 30, 1953, Madonna was united in marriage to Duane Boeckman at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. Madonna served in various capacities at St. Bernard's School and was also a devoted homemaker. She enjoyed traveling, golfing, morning coffee with the ladies, and was active in several card clubs over the years. Whether with family or friends, Madonna always enjoyed socializing with people.
