Marcella Kanne, 86, of Carroll, died Friday, August 14, 2015 at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Born on January 16, 1929, at Carroll, Iowa, Marcella was the daughter of John B. and Leota (Murphy) Hannasch. She grew up near Roselle and attended school at Holy Angels School. Marcella then graduated as salutatorian from St. Angela's Academy in 1947. On December 30, 1950 Marcella was united in marriage to James A. Kanne at Holy Angels Catholic Church in Roselle. The couple made their home in Carroll, where Marcella was a devoted homemaker.

Marcella enjoyed playing Bridge, golf, reading, and volunteering at New Hope in Carroll. Most of all Marcella enjoyed the time she spent with her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. 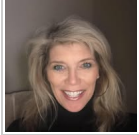
