November 26, 1927 - February 22, 2016

Marguerite Broich, 88 of Carroll, died Monday, February 22, 2016 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, February 27, 2016 at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Craig Collison. Music for the funeral mass will be by Kate Cuddy and the St. Lawrence Choir. Lectors will be Marguerite's grandchildren. Born on November 26, 1927 at Mt. Carmel, Iowa, Marguerite was the daughter of Joseph and Catherine (Leiting) Loeffelholz. She attended Our Lady of Mt. Carmel School and later in life received her diploma. Spending her childhood on her family's farm instilled hard work values.

On November 16, 1948, she was united in marriage to Paul Broich at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Catholic Church. Following their marriage Paul and Marguerite lived in the Mt. Carmel area and later built their home in Carroll where her husband co-owned and operated Paul and Waynes with Wayne Tiefenthaler. Marguerite was an accomplished homemaker and raised her family.

Marguerite enjoyed various card games; especially bridge. She also enjoyed crocheting, singing and dancing. She always cherished her time at the lake and traveling with her family and friends. She was a member of St. Lawrence Parish, and Parish Ladies Guild where she served as past president.
