Marian Grossman, age 84, of Carroll, Iowa, died Tuesday evening, May 25, 2010, at Sunnybrook of Carroll Assisted Living.

Funeral Services will be held at 10:30 A.M., Saturday, May 29, 2010, at the Pleasant Ridge Community Church south of Glidden, Iowa.
