Marie (Broich) Steinkamp, age 82, of Lake View passed away at her home on Black Hawk Lake in Lake View on Thursday, July 13, 2023.

Marie Steinkamp was born on February 16, 1941 at Carroll, Iowa to Vincent and Mary (Pudenz) Broich of Mount Carmel, Iowa. She was baptized and confirmed at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Catholic Church. Marie attended Our Lady of Mount Carmel School until its closing in 1958. She would then attend

Kuemper Catholic High School graduating in 1959. On February 4, 1961 Marie was united in marriage to Neil Steinkamp at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Catholic Church by Rev. Otmer Koester.

Marie's family and friends meant everything to her, and she was a friend to everyone who knew her. She filled her days being witty and compassionate to everyone she met.
