Marie Wunschel, 91 of Carroll, died early Friday morning, December 5, 2014 at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll following a courageous battle with cancer.

On August 19, 1947, Marie and Raymond J. Wunschel were married at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. The couple made their home in Ft. Dodge, Iowa from 1954 until 1985 where Marie ran a beauty shop out of her home. They moved to Lake View, Iowa in 1985 where she lived until 1994. Marie has resided in the Carroll Community since moving from Lake View. Marie enjoyed gardening, nature, cats, playing the organ, and camping trips with her husband Ray. She loved her annual trip to Minnesota to stay with her nephew and his wife. While in Carroll, Marie enjoyed volunteering with the hospital auxiliary, sewing rugs, helping with the chapel at Orchard View, jigsaw puzzles, and playing cards. She was grateful for the time she spent with her family.

Marie had a strong faith and was a member of Holy Spirit Parish in Carroll.

Survivors include her sister, Rita Wolterman of Adams, MN; her brother, Louis Stork of Carroll; 11 nieces and nephews; and many friends.

Marie was preceded in death by her parents; her husband Raymond in 1993; her sister Elizabeth Stork; her sisters-in-law: Agnes, Mabel, and Clara Wunschel and Lois Stork; and her brother-in-law, Harold Wolterman.
