Marlene attended country school south of Templeton. On June 15, 1954 Marlene was united in marriage to Melvin Brincks at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Templeton. The couple made their home in Carroll for five years before moving to the Roselle community. Marlene was a devoted homemaker. The couple owned and operated Trio Tavern in Roselle for 12 years. After the children were raised Marlene went to work for St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll as a housekeeper, a job she held until her retirement. Marlene enjoyed vegetable gardening, playing cards especially "Blitz", and traveling to Arizona. She also enjoyed entertaining and the time spent with her family and friends. Marlene was a member of Holy Angels Altar Society, and Holy Angels Parish in Roselle.
