Mary Ausman, age 87, of Carroll, died Thursday, October 5, 2017, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

On April 12, 1950 Mary was united in marriage to James W. Ausman at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Carroll. The couple made their home in the Carroll area.

Mary worked at General Electric in Carroll until her retirement. After retiring, she worked at Stone Printing, and volunteered at various organizations in Carroll.
