Mary Lou Harman, 88, of Carroll, died Tuesday, November 28, 2017, in Des Moines, Iowa, surrounded by her family following a brief illness.

The family lived in Evansdale, IA; Cedar Falls, IA; Coldwater, MI; and finally settled in Carroll, IA, where Mary Lou has resided for almost 50 years. She also enjoyed working for Carroll County during elections for many years.
