



Merlin "Merlie" H. Loew

January 23, 1935 - December 22, 2013

Merlin Loew, 78, of Maple River died early Sunday morning, December 22, 2013 at his home, surrounded by his family.

On January 23, 1935, Merlin and his twin sister, Marion, were born to Steven and Florence (Hermsen) Loew of Carroll, IA. Merlie attended St. Francis School and Carroll High School. He helped his family with their farm and dairy operation later going to work for Chicago Northwestern Railroad until 1968. Merlin was united in marriage to Marie Boeckman on November 23, 1957 at Wall Lake, Iowa. He returned to farming and raising livestock in the Maple River area and also owned and operated Merlie's place in Carroll. Merlie's passion was laying carpet; he owned Loew's Carpet and passed the trade down to his family. Overall Merlie just loved life; fishing, playing cards, singing, and attending exotic animal sales. His greatest joy in life though was his entire family who were by his side when he passed away Sunday morning at the age of 78. Merlie was a member of Holy Spirit Parish in Carroll.
