Neoma Ludwig, 95 of Carroll, died late Tuesday evening, February 3, 2015 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Born on May 20, 1919, Neoma was the daughter of Joseph and Catherine (Leiting) Loeffelholz. She grew up in the Mt. Carmel area, and attended school at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel School. On February 18, 1941, Neoma was united in marriage to Arthur Ludwig at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Catholic Church in Mt. Carmel. The couple made their home north of Mt. Carmel where they were both active in the grain and livestock farming operation. In addition to helping Arthur on the farm, Neoma was a devoted homemaker. Neoma enjoyed her prayer and coffee groups, sewing, crocheting, and gardening. She was an ardent choir member, and enjoyed music. Most of all, Neoma enjoyed the time she spent with her family the most. Neoma was a lifelong, active member of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Parish.
