Norma Pietig, 87 of Carroll, died early Friday morning, January 27, 2012 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

On July 13, 1943 Norma married Franklin W. Pietig at St. Joseph's Church in Carroll. Frank and Norma lived in Dedham for a brief time before making their home in Carroll. Throughout her lifetime Norma was a secretary for several businesses in the area and also volunteered at the St. Lawrence Rectory. She was a talented seamstress, enjoyed playing cards, and spending time with her family and friends. She was a member of St. Lawrence Parish, and Parish Ladies Guild.
