Patricia J. Drees, 82 of Manning, died early Wednesday morning, November 30, 2016, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Jim and Pat made their home near Manning where she was a devoted homemaker.

Pat enjoyed knitting, needle pointing, and reading. She was active with the

Democratic Central Committee, serving as precinct chairperson for several years. Pat also assisted with 4-H, as well as being a member of the Manning Catholic Daughters of the Americas. She was an avid Iowa Hawkeyes Fan, enjoyed watching them in all sporting activities, and attended numerous bowl games over the years with her husband Jim.
