Patricia Hultman, 66, of Carroll, died Monday, September 7, 2015 at her home in Carroll.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Friday, September 11, 2015 at the Sharp Funeral Home in Carroll. Fr. Timothy Johnson of Holy Spirit Catholic Church will officiate. Burial will be at Mt. Olivet Cemetery in Carroll.
