Paul Danner, age 88, of rural Carroll, died early Monday morning, December 13, 2010 at his home north of Carroll.

Born on December 30, 1921 at Carroll, Iowa, Paul Joseph Danner was the

son of Ben and Clara (Juergens) Danner. He spent his entire lifetime in the Carroll Community and attended St. Francis School in Maple River. On October 4, 1943, Paul was married to Anna Mae Sanders at Sts. Peter and Paul Church in Carroll by Fr. Lambert Schenkelberg. Following their marriage, the couple farmed for one year near Maple River and in 1944 moved to the family farm two miles north of Carroll. The Danner's observed their 50th wedding anniversary on October 4, 1993. Paul enjoyed Sunday afternoon drives, visiting with family and friends and playing with his grandchildren. Farming was not just his livelihood, but his true passion. Mr. Danner was a member of St. Lawrence Parish in Carroll.

Survivors include his children: Dennis Danner and his wife Laura of Carroll, Janet Gehling and her husband Bill of Carroll, and Jennifer Peterson and her husband Michael of Ankeny; a son in-law, Richard Sibenaller of Glidden; 18 Grandchildren, 35 Great-Grandchildren, and one Great-Great-Grandchild; one brother, Merle (Bonnie) Danner of Carroll; brothers-in-law and sisters-in-law: Sally Danner of Carroll, Betty Danner of Carroll, Kitch Semmens of Arizona and Rosemary (Keith) Fee of Minnesota.
