Paul Meyers, 91 of Carroll, died Wednesday morning, June 17, 2015 at Riverside North Nursing Home in Ames.

A funeral mass will be held at 11 a.m. Friday, June 26, 2015 at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Schott. In 1946, Paul was married to Alma Daiker at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll. To this union were three children. Following his marriage Paul held various jobs and spent most of his working career with Farmland Foods in Carroll until his retirement.

Paul was an avid antique collector and also poured a lot of love and passion into his flower garden with a special passion for roses.

As his health began to fail he moved to Ames where he was a resident at Riverside North Nursing where he passed away on Wednesday, June 17, 2015. He was a special father, brother, grandfather, and will be dearly missed. Paul was a member of St. Lawrence Church in Carroll.
