Randy “Fred” Berg, 63 of Westside, died Wednesday, March 29, 2023, at Mary Greeley Medical Center in Ames, Iowa.

Randy James Berg was born on October 2, 1959, in Carroll, Iowa, the son of Donald C. and Ardella M. (Singsank) Berg. He spent his entire lifetime in the

Westside community and attended St. John School in Arcadia, later graduating from Kuemper Catholic High School in 1978. Randy was a next generation farmer and acquired the Berg Family Farm north of Westside where he loved the land and continued to farm until his leukemia diagnosis in early 2022. Whether it was his pickups, farm equipment or the land he farmed, Randy was meticulous with his care. He loved spending time with his entire family and will always be remembered for his wit, sense of humor, and his giving, caring personality. Randy never knew a stranger and was loved by so many.

On March 29, 2022, Randy married the love of his life Jamie Hanson, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Manilla, by Pastor and good friend, Pastor Andrew Johnson. Randy became a stepfather to Dustin Wiese, Tanner Hanson, Taylor Potthoff and Papa Randy to Harper, Kora, and Kyler Potthoff.
