Born on March 26, 1955, Randy was the son of George and Helen (Eich) Eischeid. He spent his childhood growing up on a farm near Halbur then moving into town. He graduated from Kuemper Catholic High School in Carroll, IA. On August 19, 1978, Randy married DeAnn Riesselman at St. Augustine Catholic Church and they continued to build a life together in the Halbur community. Together they had three children: Matt, Angie, and Corey. He enjoyed working at Rotert Construction, Pella Windows, and hauling fuel for both Riesberg Garage and Halbur Enterprises.
