Rebecca (Becky) Hoffmann, age 69, of Carroll, died Tuesday, April 16, 2024 at her home surrounded by her family.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday, April 20, 2024 at St. Lawrence Church – St. John Paul II Parish in Carroll. The celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Schott.
