Regina Reineke, age 87 of Carroll, died Thursday, February 28, 2013, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Regina and Clarence Reineke were united in marriage on November 25, 1947, at St. Augustine Church in Halbur. Following

their marriage the couple farmed southeast of Carroll until 1971 when they moved to their home in Carroll. Regina was a homemaker and helped Clarence with the farm chores. She was a member of St. Lawrence Parish and the Parish Ladies Guild. Regina enjoyed her family, playing cards, polka music, and visiting with her family and friends.

Regina is survived by her two sons, Don (Phyllis) Reineke of Corning and Leon Reineke of Creston; five granddaughters; seven great grandchildren; a sister, Verna Mayer of Carroll; four brothers, Fred (Lucille) Wittrock of Audubon, Robert (Arlene) Wittrock of Mt. Carmel, Harold (JoAnn) Wittrock of Templeton, and Roman (Verena) Wittrock of Carroll; and by sisters-in-law, Tillie Reineke of Carroll and Marie Nieland of Storm Lake.
