Remona lived in Breda nearly her entire lifetime and was a homemaker and enjoyed sewing, quilting, gardening, talking on her cell phone and spending time with her family. She was a member of St. Bernard's Parish, Parish Ladies Guild, and the Breda American Legion Auxiliary for over 50 years.
