Robert "Bob" Broich, 94 of Carroll, died Tuesday, March 24, 2020 at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Born on August 2, 1925 at Willey, Iowa, Robert was the son of John J. and Emilia (Neppi) Broich. He attended St. Mary's School in Willey. After graduation Bob worked for area farmers as well as helping his parents with their farm operation. On December 29, 1948, Bob was united in marriage to Edra Weeks at Annunciation Catholic Church in Coon Rapids, Iowa. The couple raised their family and farmed in the Willey area. In 1965 they bought their farm east of Viola Center. In 2001, following their retirement, Bob and Edra moved to Carroll.

Bob enjoyed fishing, playing cards, woodworking and tending to the farm. His greatest joy was spending time with his family. Bob was a member of St. John Paul II Parish – St. Lawrence Church in Carroll.
