Roger Lynch, 83 of Carroll, died early Tuesday morning, May 29, 2012 at the Swan House in Carroll.

Born on October 14, 1928 at Vail, Iowa, Roger John was the son of John and Frances (Costello) Lynch. He spent his younger years on a farm in the Vail-

Westside area and enjoyed playing basketball and riding his horse. Roger attended St. Ann's Grade School and later graduated from St. Ann's High School. On July 8, 1952 he married Veronica "Roni" Higgins at St. Ann's Catholic Church in Vail, Iowa. The couple moved to California where he served in the United States Navy during the Korean War. Following his honorable discharge they returned to the Carroll area where he worked for the Crouse Cartage Company for 32 years. He enjoyed reading, watching western movies, and dancing with Roni. Roger loved his family and always enjoyed watching and supporting all the activities his grandchildren participated in. He was a member of the Carroll American Legion, Maurice Dunn Post # 7, and Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Carroll.

Roger is survived by his children: Kath Forke and her husband Gary of Carroll, Tom Lynch and his wife Sheryl of Carroll, and Lu Berger and her husband Denny of Frasier, CO; 11 grandchildren; 6 great-grandchildren; one sister-in-law, Helen Higgins of Vail; as well as other extended relatives.
