



## Ronald William Siepker

July 2, 1941 - January 23, 2022

Ronald William Siepker, age 80, died Sunday, January 23, 2022, at home in Overland Park, Kansas.

He died of cancer surrounded by his loving family.

A funeral mass will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, January 26, 2022 at St. Lawrence Church- St. John Paul II Parish in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Patrick Behm. obtaining the rank of Petty Officer 2nd Class-E5, and honorably discharged in 1967.

He worked for the State of Iowa for 34 years as supervisor for the Iowa Liquor Commission and auditor for the Iowa Department of Inspections & Appeals. Ron married Joyce Knudson October 28, 1991.

They retired to Roswell, New Mexico for 14 years and at the urging of family moved to Overland Park to be near them. He enjoyed golfing, gambling, planning and traveling to his reunions with the USS Dixie.

Ron is survived by step-daughters Andrea Rogan (John) of Lenexa, Kansas, Alana Johnstone (Andy) of Milo, Iowa, and three Grandchildren, Aric, Jack, and Alexander.
