Rosemary Schon, age 79, of Carroll, Iowa, died early Friday, June 04, 2010, at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll. Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 A.M., Monday, June 7, 2010, at Holy Spirit Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Father Timothy Johnson assisted by Rosie's son, Deacon Gary Schon. The casket will be taken to the church at 8:30 A.M. Monday to lie in state until the time of the funeral mass. She spent her lifetime in the Carroll community and attended Saint Peter and Paul School and graduated from St. Angela Academy. On November 27, 1950, she was married to Leo Schon at Saint Peter and Paul Church in Carroll. The couple farmed southwest of Glidden until 1987 when they moved to their home in Carroll. Rosie was a homemaker and devoted

mother. She was a member of Holy Spirit Parish and Parish Ladies Guild.
