February 1, 1930 - December 21, 2010

Rudell Snyder, age 80, of Carroll, died peacefully, surrounded by his family, early Tuesday morning, December 21, 2010 at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 11 a.m., Thursday, December 23, 2010 at Holy Spirit Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Johnson. Born on February 1, 1930 at Carroll, Iowa, Rudell Frank Snyder was the son of Mathew and Minnie (Rutten) Snyder. He spent his entire lifetime in the Carroll Community and attended St. Lawrence School. Following his schooling, Rudy began working various jobs and also assisted his family with their farm operation. He then began working for Heider Manufacturing in Carroll where he worked for over 30 years. Rudell was married to Ruth Ann

Kennebeck on November 14, 1949 at St. Mary's Church in Willey, Iowa. Rudy was a simple man; a man of little words; but a man who was a great role model as a husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather. He loved a good ball game. He cherished his time at home and always had some small project that needed doing. Mr. Snyder was a member of Holy Spirit Parish in Carroll.
