Ruth Diers, 92 of Arcadia, died Thursday, December 23, 2021 at Regency Park Nursing Home in Carroll.

She was a member of St. John's Choir for 39 years, Eucharistic Minister at church and for homebound people, a member of St John's Guild where she served as president. She also was secretary of St. Johns school board, served on Arcadia senior citizen board, worked as a volunteer at New Hope Village Bargain Shop for 25 years and took meals to homebound people. She enjoyed playing bridge, games and socializing with friends.
