Sharon Sporrer, 68 of Dedham, died Sunday, October 9, 2022, at her home near Dedham.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, October 12, 2022, at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Dedham. The Celebrant will be Fr. Merlin Schrad. Deacon Greg Archunde and Deacon Louis Meiners will assist with Funeral Mass. Music will be by Cindy Bauer and the parish choir. Lectors will be Addison Archunde, Jill Spies and Amy Overmohle. Sharon (Schmitz) Sporrer was born on September 28, 1954, to Walter and Louise (Gehling) Schmitz in Carroll, IA. She grew up on a farm south of Templeton. Sharon attended Sacred Heart School in Templeton and graduated from Kuemper High School in Carroll in 1972. She graduated from

Commercial Extension in Omaha and worked many years in the clerical field. Sharon and Richard (Dick) Sporrer were married on August 20, 1977, by Fr. Merlin Schrad at Sacred Heart Church in Templeton. They made their home on the family farm west of Dedham. Three children were born to this 45-year union: Becky, Barry and Terry.

The couple were blessed with ten grandchildren: Addison & Logan Archunde; Hannah, Charlotte & Josephine Sporrer; Erin, Ella, Ben, Kara & Brooklyn Sporrer. Her children and grandchildren were the joy of her life.
