Shirley Schachtner, 84 of Carroll, died early Monday morning, November 17, 2014 at the Carroll Health Center Nursing Home in Carroll.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday, November, 22, 2014 at the Sharp Funeral Home in Carroll. Rev. Mark Peterson, Chaplain of Gentiva Hospice will officiate.
