



## Teresa Koster

October 24, 1918 - October 31, 2011

Teresa Koster, 93 of Wymore, Nebraska, and formerly of Breda, died Monday, October 31, 2011 at the Wymore Good Samaritan Center in Wymore.

A funeral mass will be held at 11 a.m., Friday, November 4, 2011 at St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Breda. The Celebrant will be Fr. Joe Dillinger. Con-Celebrant will be Fr. Dale Koster. Lector for the funeral mass will be Pat Koster. Gift Bearers will be Teresa's Granddaughters, Amy Sorensen, Christina Bruenelle and Amanda Gibson. At the age of five she moved with her family to Santa Clara, California where she attended school. On December 1, 1945 she married Floyd Koster following his discharge from the United States Army. Floyd and Teresa then moved to Ames while Floyd attended Iowa State University. Following his graduation they moved to Washington, Iowa and then to Alton, Iowa until Floyd's retirement. While in Alton, she raised five children, and also worked at Kahout Cap Factory. After retirement Floyd and Teresa moved to Breda and also spent part of each year in Las Vegas and traveled

the country to visit their children. At the age of 90 she and Floyd moved to the Good Samaritan Center in Wymore, Nebraska to be near their daughter Carol and their grandchildren. She enjoyed bowling, traveling, visiting her children, playing Keno, and flower gardening. She especially enjoyed the many winters they spent in Las Vegas, and they always remembered their 50th Wedding Anniversary party at Las Vegas with the many family members who came to share it with them. Teresa was a 50 year member of the American Legion Auxiliary, and throughout her lifetime was a member at St. Mary's Church in Alton, St. Bernard's Church in Breda, and most recently a member of St. Mary's Church in Wymore.
