April 16, 1987 - April 18, 2014

Tyler Riesberg, 27 of Omaha, Nebraska and formerly of Roselle, died Friday morning at his residence in Omaha surrounded by his family.

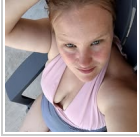
