



## Vernis Bueltel

March 2, 1922 - March 3, 2015

Vernis Bueltel, age 93, of Carroll, died Tuesday, March 3, 2015, at the Carroll Health Center in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Monday, March, 9, 2015 at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Schott. Born on March 2, 1922 on a farm near Arcadia, Iowa, Vernis was the son of John and Kathryn (Weber) Bueltel. He grew up near the Arcadia community,

and attended school at St. John's School in Arcadia. After his schooling, Vernis began farming, and farmed his entire life until his retirement when he moved to the Carroll community. He enjoyed fishing, golf, gardening, and softball where he played pitcher for the Arcadia traveling team. Vernis was a former member of St. John's Catholic Church in Arcadia, and a current member of St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Carroll.
