Vernon Eischeid, age 56, of rural Manning, Iowa, died Friday, April 23, 2010, at his residence following a battle with cancer.

Vernon was born on July 28, 1953, at Carroll, Iowa, the son of George and Helen (Eich) Eischeid. He attended St. Augustine School in Halbur and graduated from Kuemper High School in 1971. On August 24, 1974, he was married to Diane Behrens at St. Augustine Church in Halbur. The couple lived for a short time in Papillion, Nebraska, where he worked for a construction company and in 1975 moved to their farm home north of Manning. In April

1978 Vernon started his own construction business and the company operates today as a family business. He was a member of Holy Spirit Parish. Vernon loved his family, especially his grandchildren, and enjoyed restoring Mopar cars, going to car shows, and tinkering in his shop.
