Vernon Joseph Weber, 73, of Carroll passed away early Tuesday morning, February 4, 2020, at Iowa Methodist Hospital in Des Moines after a short battle with prolymphocytic T-cell leukemia.

Vern was born June 4, 1946 to Bernard and Margaret (Daniel) Weber in Carroll, Iowa. Vern attended St. Peter Paul Catholic School and graduated from Kuemper High School in 1964. After graduation, he was drafted to the Army and was a Vietnam veteran. Vern was employed by Pepsi Cola Bottling Company and later at the US Postal Service, retiring after 34 years of service. On June 15, 1968 Vern and Jean Ratigan were united in marriage at Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Carroll. To this union were born 4 children.

Vern was an avid Iowa Hawkeye fan and Chicago Cubs fan. Playing cards was one of his favorite past times. He tremendously enjoyed attending his grandchildren's school events and sport's competitions. He volunteered at same day surgery at St. Anthony's hospital. Vern was a church usher and Eucharistic Minister.
