Virgil "Buddy" Neumayer, age 84, of Breda, Iowa, died late Sunday evening, September 26, 2010 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated 10:30 a.m., Thursday at St. Bernard's Church in Breda. The celebrant will be Father Joe Dillinger. Following his schooling Buddy began farming. On May 5, 1947 he was married to Betty Van Erdewyk at St. Bernard's Church in Breda, Iowa by Father Leroy Frank. Buddy farmed east of Breda and stayed active in the

farming operation for his entire life. In 1984 Buddy and Betty moved from the farm into Breda. Buddy loved farming, taking road trips to check the crops, and spending time with his family. He was a member of St. Bernard's Church in Breda, and the Breda Catholic Order of Foresters.
