June 22, 1936 - March 7, 2011

Wanda Tigges, age 74 of Carroll, formerly of Willey, died early Monday morning, March 7, 2011 at St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll. Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 1:30 p.m., Friday at St. Mary's Church in Willey. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Johnson. Lector for the funeral mass will be Matt Tigges. She spent her younger years in the Gray community and attended Gray Consolidated School, graduating with the Class of 1954. Wanda married Aldred "Allie" Tigges on January 28, 1956 at St. Joseph's Church in Dedham, Iowa. The couple farmed near Willey and Wanda was a homemaker for her entire life. In May of 2000, Wanda moved to

Carroll. She was a member of St. Mary's Parish and Parish Ladies Guild, and the Dedham American Legion Auxiliary.
