July 17, 1915 - December 20, 2008

Wesley Ohde, age 93, of Carroll, Iowa, died Saturday, December 20, 2008, at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha, Nebraska. Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 A.M., Tuesday, December 23, 2008, at St. Lawrence Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Father Timothy Schott. piano for three dance bands, The Harmony Boys, The Ray Ohde Band, and The Music Men Band. He was a member of St. Lawrence Parish. Mr. Ohde enjoyed his family, music, playing golf, and traveling.
