William “Bill” Carr, was born on October 21, 1934 to Louis and Mary Carr in

Jersey City, New Jersey. He graduated from St. Peter's College in New Jersey. Bill began working for Continental Insurance Company in Trenton, New Jersey, and Mt. Lebanon, Pennsylvania, where he met and married his beloved wife, Terry Malone.

Bill and Terry moved to Runnemede, New Jersey then Overland Park, Kansas. In 1975 Bill began working for The Iowa Bankers Association, and he and Terry relocated to Carroll, Iowa. Bill enjoyed meeting many bankers throughout Western Iowa, finishing as vice president of Iowa Bankers Insurance and Services. In 1996 Bill and Terry retired to Ocean Springs, Mississippi where he began another career working for Kansas Bankers Insurance, a company owned by Warren Buffet.

After traveling extensively in Mississippi and Louisiana, Bill decided in 1999 that it was time to retire again.
