Bill Schenkelberg, 88 of Carroll, died early Friday morning, October 23, 2015 at St. Anthony Nursing Home in Carroll.

Mass of the Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, October 27, 2015 at Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Carroll. The Celebrant will be Fr. Timothy Johnson. Born on January 1, 1927 at Carroll, Iowa, William Lambert was the son of William and Sophie (Schmitz) Schenkelberg. Bill attended grade school in Carroll and later graduated from Carroll High School. Following his schooling he served in the United States Navy from 1944-1946 and following his honorable discharge returned to the Carroll area. Bill was united in marriage to Jean Wernimont on May 19, 1951 at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Catholic Church in Mt. Carmel. Bill started his career with Schenkelberg Manufacturing as an on the road salesman. In 1951, his father purchased the John Deere Dealership which became Schenkelberg Implement. Bill co-owned and operated the business until his retirement but always maintained a vested interest in the business. Over the years Bill and Jean enjoyed wintering in Arizona and traveling in general. Bill loved to play cards, golf, socializing with his friends, and spending time at the Carroll Country Club. Bill's greatest joy was spending time with his entire family.
